

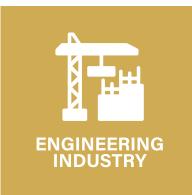

2020: The Beginning of a Vision

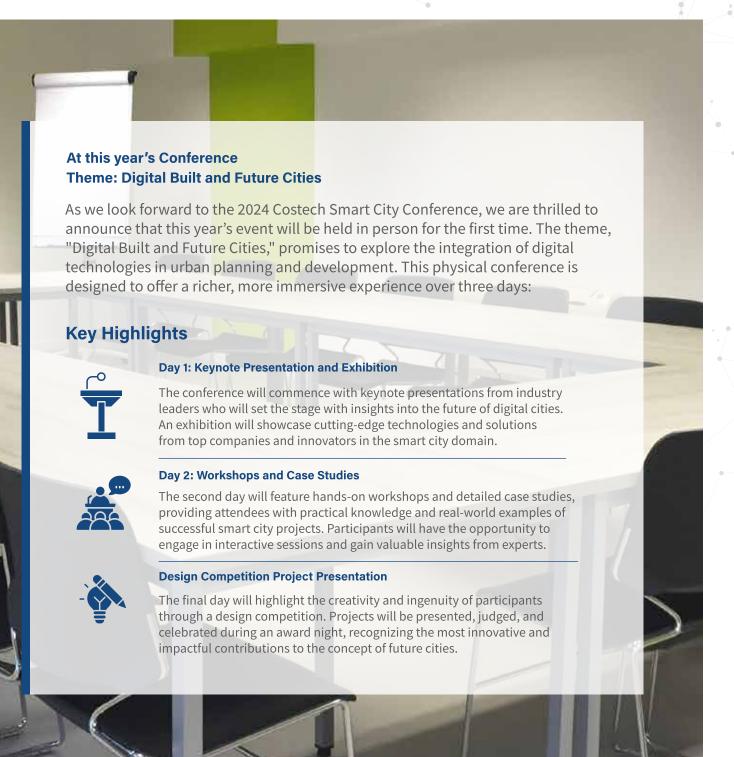

About Competition

In pursuit of fostering creativity and promoting innovative ideas for the advancement of design and engineering, Costech Computers invites students from across the country to engage in a thought-provoking discussion on the transformative potential of Autodesk software in shaping the future of design and engineering.

Stage 1: Write up

As a group of four students, create a 1000-word document outlining innovative solutions to ensure a smart building's sustainability, in line with the united Nations sustainable development goals

Stage 2: design concept

Students are required to produce sketches to illustrate the design concept that they recommend for ensuring optimal sustainability in the smart, office building. Focusing on the architectural, structural, electrical and mechanical engineering considerations.

Stage 3: Final design development

Students are expected to transform the design concepts into comprehensive and polished final design. This stage requires detailed and precise work. Students are to produce full set of architectural, structural, electrical and mechanical drawings, adhering strictly to building regulations and town planning laws. They must ensure that the final design aligns with the sustainability goals set by the united nations sustainable goals (SDGs), particularly focusing on SDGs 7,11, and 13. The submission should clearly demonstrate the innovative and practical aspects of design, showcasing the ability to create a smart, sustainable building
